Job Objective

Reporting directly to Technical Services Manager, the Lead WWTP Operator has full responsibility for the successful operation and maintenance of the SPA III facility and assisting at the SPA II Water Recycling Facilities and Collection Systems as needed. The SPA III WRF is a 1.8 MGD Facility that utilizes Sequencing Batch Reactor (SBR) technology with Disc Filtration and UV Disinfection.

Principal Duties and Responsibilities

- Perform equipment operation and maintenance
- Perform treatment plant rounds including inspecting, monitoring and documenting plant operations
- Troubleshoot process and equipment problems
- Supervise and manage operation & maintenance personnel including responsibility for training, performance evaluations etc.
- Operate, inspect and service sewer collection systems and lift stations as applicable
- Collect and analyze wastewater samples
- Facilitate sampling analysis for regulatory reporting
- Interpret and report process data
- Setup and implement CMMS program
- Operate valves & equipment
- Communicate any problems/issues to supervisor
- Perform weed abatement by spraying and or manual removal as needed.
- Housekeeping duties on plant grounds lift stations, and office buildings.
- Promote and adhere to PERC's written corporate Safety program
- All other tasks as assigned by supervisor
- Maintain acceptable attendance per PERC standards

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities Required

1. General computer skills including good working knowledge of Microsoft Outlook, Word and Excel. Ability to learn CMMS program used on site.
2. Excellent team-working and communications skills to enable effective interaction with other PERC Water personnel, including peers. Able to establish and maintain effective working relationships with others.
