Job Objective

Reporting directly to Chief Plant Operator, the Grade III Operator in Charge has responsibility for the successful operation and maintenance of the City of Pacific Grove's 0.25 MGD Water Recycling Facility. The facility includes MBR technology with UV disinfection.

Principal Duties and Responsibilities

- Perform operation and maintenance
- Perform treatment plant rounds including inspecting, monitoring and documenting plant operations
- Make necessary adjustment to maintain process control parameters to produce recycled water
- Troubleshoot process and mechanical equipment problems
- Operate, inspect and maintain diversion structure and influent lift stations
- Collect and analyze samples to maintain process control
- Interpret and report data from Certified Lab
- Operate valves & equipment
- Manage treated water storage tanks and recycled water pumping
- Maintain facility Computerized Maintenance Management System (CMMS)
- Work closely with Golf Course Superintendent and other recycled water customers
- Communicate any problems/issues to supervisor
- Complete and submit reports
- Interact with regulatory agencies, clients and associates
- Housekeeping duties on plant grounds lift stations, and office buildings.
- Promote and adhere to PERC's written corporate Safety program
- All other tasks as assigned by Chief Plant Operator
- Maintain acceptable attendance per PERC standards
